

Pastor Interview Guide

Two workshops covering an orientation to family planning for Christians were provided by CHAK on November 4th and 10th, 2011 at Maua and Embu respectively. The following questions will provide data on the impact of these workshops.

1. What did you learn during the family planning workshop that you did not know before?
2. How has your perception of family planning changed since the workshop?
 - a. In the past, did you have concerns about family planning methods?
 - b. Would you recommend all the family planning methods you learned about to your congregation?
 - c. What would you say to a community member who was fearful of/against using family planning?
3. Do you speak to your congregation about family planning? Can you give me some examples?
4. Do you provide pre-marital counseling to parishioners?
 - a. If so, do you talk about family planning? In what way?
 - b. Has your approach changed since the workshop? [i.e. asking couples about family planning, giving them information about family planning, using the guide, referring them to CHW, etc.]
5. What is the perception of family planning among your parishioners?
 - a. Do they use family planning?
 - b. Have they expressed concerns about family planning? [Men or women?]
6. Did you receive the discussion guide for Christian small groups when you attended the workshop? If so, how have you used it?
 - a. What do you find most helpful about the discussion guide? [uses scripture, Africa-specific, includes scientific information about each method, which section is most useful, etc.]
 - b. Would you change anything about it?
