THE PROBLEMS ARE MANY, ARE THE WORKERS FEW?

THERE HISTORICALLY HAVE BEEN AN ABUNDANCE OF NGOS WORKING IN HAITI

ONE OF THE BIGGEST CHALLENGES WE HAVE ENCOUNTERED IS THE DISCONNECT BETWEEN ORGANIZATIONS – EVEN THOSE WORKING IN THE SAME REGION HAVE HISTORICALLY KEPT VERY SEPARATE FROM EACH OTHER. THERE HAS NOT BEEN GOOD COLLABORATION OR COMMUNICATION BETWEEN MANY OF THE ORGANIZATIONS WORKING IN HAITI.

IT WAS IN THIS ENVIRONMENT THE DESIRE AND NEED FOR THE HAITI HEALTH NETWORK WAS BORN.









ONE ANOTHER.








